

1. Whanau Ora Services:

Strategic Plan: The removal of the Mangroves from the Puhinui stream

1. The enhancement of the amenity of the Puhinui inlet to create a strong "SENSE OF PLACE" for the Manurewa Community
2. The promotion and enhancement of recreational use and enjoyment of the Puhinui inlet.
3. The protection of cultural and heritage areas of importance and the preservation of the history of these significant areas.
4. The increased awareness and understanding of these historical areas.
5. The restoration and protection of the environmental quality and important ecosystems within the Puhinui inlet.

ARC - Submission:

In April 2008, the Manurewa Marae put forward a submission, to the Auckland Regional Plan. We also collected names and signatures of people within the community who supported this project. We have been informed that a verbal presentation will be required in September 2008, to further this application., we would like to submit the response forms with this presentation.

Where to from here:

We would now like to gather more feedback from our local community on how they feel about this project, and if they would support us to have the mangroves removed, so we can utilize the foreshore. If we are successful with our submission we will be requiring the support from the community to physically remove the mangroves.
